With her extensive background in social work and first-hand experience working with foster children, Margie Wright brings a unique perspective to her role as chairman of the Wednesday's Child Benefit Corporation board of trustees.

Wright had an extensive career of 30 years at Child Protective Services (CPS), holding positions as caseworker, supervisor and program director. She held the program administrator's position for her final three years with CPS. She is a Licensed Master Social Worker and a field instructor for several universities, including University of Texas at Dallas and University of Texas at Arlington. Wright holds a master's degree in social work from the University of Texas at Arlington.

Wright currently serves as the executive director at the Suicide & Crisis Center of Dallas. She is an active community volunteer who is on the board of the Child Abuse Prevention Center of Dallas and is a past chair of the Children's Mental Health Committee for the Dallas Mental Health Association.

Wright is a member of the executive committee for the Texas Suicide Prevention Community Network and was a delegate to the Bi-Regional Suicide Prevention Conference sponsored by the Suicide Prevention Resource Center and Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration.
